

Dyfarniad Agored Cymru Lefel 2 – Torri Ewinedd a Gofalu Amdanynt

Ar gael o Dachwedd 1af 2013 ymlaen

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Cynlluniwyd y Fframwaith Cymwysterau a Chredydau (FfCCh) hwn i ddatblygu gwybodaeth a sgiliau dysgwyr er mwyn iddynt allu cynnig gwasanaeth torri ewinedd. Fe'i hanelir at weithlu newydd sy'n gallu diwallu anghenion pobl nad ydynt yn gallu torri eu hewinedd eu hunain na gofalu amdanynt.

Pam defnyddio'r cymhwyster FfCCh hwn?

- Cymeradwyir y cymhwyster hwn gan Sgiliau ar gyfer Iechyd, ac mae'n gysylltiedig â safonau galwedigaethol cenedlaethol.
- Ar ôl ei gwblhau, bydd dysgwyr yn gallu darparu gofal rwtin ar gyfer ewinedd traed a thraed ac ewinedd dwylo a dwylo, megis golchi traed a/neu ddwylo, torri ewinedd, tylino dwylo a thraed yn ysgafn, a phaentio ewinedd.
- Mae hefyd yn cynnwys elfennau nad yw'r cymwysterau trin dwylo a thrin traed yn ymwneud â hwy, ac mae'n paratoi dysgwyr ar gyfer torri ewinedd o safbwynt gofal iechyd.

Er enghraifft:

- Torri ewinedd a rhoi gofal i unigolion sydd wedi colli un neu ragor o'u synhwyrau, sydd ag anhawster gwybyddol, anabledd corfforol, anabledd dysgu, salwch meddwl, neu ddiabetes.

- Torri ewinedd sydd wedi mynd yn drwchus.
- Torri ewinedd ffwngaidd.
- Atal cwympiadau.
- Atgyfeirio at wasanaethau gofal iechyd a hyrwyddo iechyd eraill.

Nid yw'r cymhwyster yn:

- Wasanaeth podiatreg.
- Ar gyfer dysgwyr neu weithwyr cefnogi sy'n cyflawni tasgau a ddirprwywyd iddynt gan bodiatregydd.
- Yn disodli cymwysterau harddwch cyfredol mewn gofal traed a gofal dwylo.

Ar gyfer pwy?

Mae grŵp targed y cymhwyster yn cynnwys:

- Gweithwyr cefnogi mewn lleoliadau gofal iechyd sy'n gweithio o fewn protocol a gweithdrefnau cytunedig ac sy'n awyddus i ehangu eu sgiliau.
- Technegwyr ewinedd sydd â chymwysterau mewn trin dwylo a thrin traed ac sydd eisiau ehangu eu sgiliau.
- Pobl sydd newydd ymuno â'r sector sydd eisiau gweithio fel ymarferwyr annibynnol.

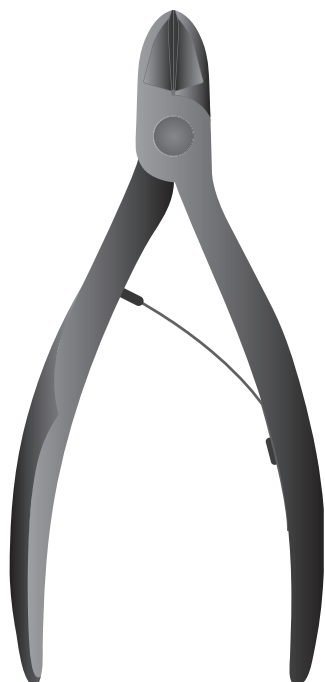

Agored Cymru Level 2 Award in Nail Cutting and Care

Available from November 1st 2013

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This Qualification and Credit Framework (QCF) qualification is designed to develop the knowledge and skills of learners to work in independent nail cutting practice. It is intended for a new workforce who can meet the needs of those individuals who cannot manage nail cutting and care for themselves.

Why use this QCF qualification?

- The qualification is approved by Skills for Health and mapped to national occupational standards.
- On completion, learners will be able to provide routine care for normal toe nails and feet, and finger nails and hands, such as foot and/or hand bathing, nail cutting, gentle hand and foot massage, and nail painting.
- It also includes elements not covered by manicure and pedicure qualifications, and prepares learners to approach the delivery of nail cutting from a healthcare perspective.

For example:

- Providing nail cutting and care to individuals with sensory loss, cognitive difficulty, physical disability, learning disability, mental ill health, or who have diabetes

- Cutting nails which may be thickened
- Trimming fungal nails
- Falls prevention
- Referral to other health care and health promotion services.

The qualification is not:

- A podiatry service
- For learners or support workers undertaking delegated tasks from a podiatrist
- A replacement for existing beauty qualifications in pedicure and manicure.

Who is it for?

The qualification target group includes:

- Support workers in healthcare settings who work to agreed protocol and procedures and wish to extend their skills
- Nail technicians who have qualifications in manicure and pedicure and who wish to extend their skills
- New entrants to the sector who wish to work as independent practitioners.
